Job: Ceramic Tiler

Aims & Objectives: To gain an insight into working as a ceramic tiler with a building company.

Key Tasks: Student will do a certain amount of observation then after training and under supervision may do simple tasks. Under instruction student may be able to cut tiles using a tile cutter and be able to use a grinder. Student may be shown how to fix tiles using water based adhesives and be able to do tile grouting. It may be possible that the student will assist in pulling down ceilings and/or walls.

Requirements: Student should have a genuine interest in tiling and the building trade. Should have common sense, be sensible and prepared to listen to instructions.

Clothing: Work clothes e.g. jeans should be worn, but student needs to be neat and tidy. Hard hats and high visibility jackets will be provided if necessary and steel toe capped boots would be preferred (trainers may be acceptable if none available from Careers)

Working Hours: 8am to 5pm, Monday to Friday

Meal Breaks: 30mins break from 9.30-10am, one hour for lunch - lunchtimes may be unsupervised
