Aims & To develop key skills through the experience of work.

Objectives: To gain an insight into working in the leisure and golfing area of a hotel complex.

Students will spend time in each area to give an overall appreciation of the activities.

Key Tasks: Student will spend a day in the golf pro shop assisting with customers, tidying and cleaning and

collecting golf balls from the driving range. Student may assist with on line sales for

www.jamgolf.com. Observation of golf lessons.

Some time will be spent in the golf club office assisting with administration and general office duties such as photocopying, filing and faxing, student may also assist in organising corporate golf days and competitions.

Student will spend a day with the green keepers where after training and under supervision may do basic golf course maintenance such as weeding, replacing divots and other tasks such as raking bunkers.

Some golf centres have leisure suites, therefore student may be assisting trained staff in the gym, pool and sauna/steam room areas. Student may observe personal training sessions, exercise classes and be shown the safe use of the exercise machines, it may be possible to observe pool testing for water quality and to assist with general leisure club maintenance such as cleanliness in the wet and dry changing areas. (Depending on which golf club you go to). Students may be able to assist with some admin duties and updating the social media sites.

The last day will be spent in the area of student's choice.

Requirements: Student must have a keen interest in golf and leisure clubs. Good communication skills, friendly and

highly motivated. Good IT skills. Able to listen and follow instructions.
