Aims & Objectives: To develop key skills through the experience of work
To gain an insight into working in diamond drilling.

Key Tasks: Students can expect a certain amount of site safety training, observation of drills and saws and then after training and under supervision may do basic tasks. Duties may include marking out for drilling, training in modular drills and assembling them. Work can be at private homes or on large building sites.(Drills bolt to the walls there is no hand held drilling).

Requirements: Students must be honest, punctual and reliable. Must not be afraid to get dirty.

Clothing: Working clothes that can get dirty. Steel toe capped boots are required. (Boots may be borrowed from the Careers Service on deposit. Tel: 706567 to check sizes available.)

Working Hours: Monday Friday 8.00am 4.00pm Maximum 37 hours per week.

Meal Breaks: 1 Hour lunch break packed lunch advised or cash for buying food at shops.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT: Hard hats, goggles, ear defenders and high visibility jackets will be provided and must be worn as directed.
