If you have applied to university and you do not meet the conditions of any offers you are holding, you can use the [UCAS Clearing service](#). Log in to UCAS Track to check your status and if you are eligible to enter Clearing.

This year UCAS are again offering their direct contact service to applicants – designed to help those who find themselves without a university or college place. For 2018, this service will be available for those eligible for Clearing, helping applicants who find themselves unplaced. [Direct contact service](#)

If your results are higher than you were expecting, you may be eligible to use the [UCAS Adjustment](#) Service.
