If you have applied to university......

Log in to <u>UCAS Track</u> and follow the instructions provided. If you have changed your mind about your university offer, follow the <u>UCAS advice</u> about the options to enter Clearing or contact a Careers Adviser at <u>careersguernsey@gov.gg</u> or T: 706565

If you now want to apply to university.....

You will need to register through Clearing and check the courses which still have vacancies to check whether this is an option for you. Follow the <u>UCAS advice</u> or contact a Careers Adviser at <u>careersguernsey@gov.gg</u> or T: 706565

Results not what you were expecting?

If you have applied to university and you do not meet the conditions of any offers you are holding, you can use the <u>UCAS Clearing service</u>. Log in to UCAS Track to check your status and if you are eligible to enter Clearing.

UCAS offer a direct contact service to applicants to help if you are without a university or college place. This service allows universities and colleges to make direct contact with you about a place on a relevant course once you've received your results. The service is entirely optional and you don't have to accept any offers you receive. You will receive an e-mail invitation from UCAS with the option to sign up to this free service.
