If you have applied to university.....

Log in to [UCAS Track](#) and follow the instructions provided. If you have changed your mind about your university offer, follow the [UCAS advice](#) about the options to enter Clearing or contact a Careers Adviser at careersguernsey@gov.gg or T: 706565.

You will need to register through **Clearing** and check the courses which still have vacancies to check whether this is an option for you. Follow the [UCAS advice](#) or contact a Careers Adviser at careersguernsey@gov.gg or T: 706565.

Results not what you were expecting?

If you have applied to university and you do not meet the conditions of any offers you are holding, you can use the [UCAS Clearing service](#). Log in to UCAS Track to check your status and if you are eligible to enter Clearing.

UCAS are offering a new service this year called **Clearing Plus** (which replaces the direct contact service) where if you find yourself in clearing UCAS can personally match you to courses you may be interested in, using what they know about you from your application and what universities and colleges are looking for in a student. If you want to apply for something different you can still find courses available in **Clearing** using the search tool.

If your results are higher than you were expecting and you meet and exceed the conditions of your firm choice, you may be eligible to use the [UCAS Adjustment Service](#). More information on UCAS Adjustment can be found [here](#)
