



Information for Alderney Students



As an Alderney student you face the same decisions as Guernsey students. However, there is extra information you will find helpful about accommodation in Guernsey whilst you study, working in Guernsey legislation and employment opportunities in Alderney.

Staying on in full time education

Alderney students can choose to study their post-16 education in Guernsey or some students choose to study in the UK as their families moved over to Alderney from the UK originally.

Alderney students studying in Guernsey are supported by the Health & Social Services Department in terms of accommodation and living arrangements. Download the HSSD Alderney Students information in the Yr10 & Yr11 'Finding out about options' section.

Students visit the Sixth Form Centre in Guernsey and College before they fill out an application form.

Year 11 students can choose to study the following Post-16 options:

- A levels or the IB Diploma at the 6th Form Centre in Guernsey
- Vocational Qualifications at the College of FE in Guernsey
- Further Education in the UK

Apprenticeship in Alderney

The Apprenticeship Scheme will support the employer and apprentice with funding to allow day release to the College of FE in Guernsey.
