



Information for Alderney Students Post-16

As an Alderney student you face the same decisions as Guernsey students. However, there is extra information you will find helpful about accommodation in Guernsey whilst you study, working in Guernsey legislation and employment opportunities in Alderney.

Staying on in full time education

Alderney students can choose to study their post-16 education in Guernsey or some students choose to study in the UK as their families moved over to Alderney from the UK originally. Alderney students studying in Guernsey are supported by the Health & Social Care (HSC) Department in terms of accommodation and living arrangements. Download the information leaflet regarding accommodation for Alderney, Herm and Sark students receiving education in Guernsey, on the Careers Guernsey website www.careers.gg in the Yr10 & Yr11 'Finding out about options' and 'I am an Alderney student' section. Students visit the Sixth Form Centre and College of Further Education in Guernsey before they fill out an application form.

Year 11 students can choose to study the following full time Post-16 options:

- A levels and IB Certificates, IB Diploma or the IB Career-related Programme at the Sixth Form Centre in Guernsey
- Vocational Qualifications at the College of FE in Guernsey
- Further Education in the UK

Apprenticeship in Guernsey * Important

Students and parents/carers need to be aware of the Housing and Permit regulations for Alderney residents wanting to live and work in Guernsey. It is possible to work as an apprentice in Guernsey as some St Anne's students in the past have found apprenticeships in Catering, Building Trades and Engineering. **BUT** it is important to be aware of the regulations for living and working in Guernsey. The current Policy is still being reviewed at this time and there should be an update in early 2019.
